A checklist for licensed clinicians considering clinical supervision.

LICENSURE & EXPERIENCE

- ☐ I hold independent/clinical licensure (LCSW) in my state.
- ☐ I have at least 2 years of post-licensure clinical experience.
- ☐ I am in good standing with my state licensing board.

TIME & CAPACITY

- ☐ I have capacity to take on 1–3 supervisees without compromising my own caseload.
- ☐ I have reliable, protected time each week for supervision sessions and documentation.
- ☐ I have (or can build) a private, compliant space for telesupervision.

SKILL & READINESS

- ☐ I can give direct, constructive feedback without softening it into vagueness.
- ☐ I'm comfortable holding an evaluative role, not just a supportive one.
- ☐ I understand the legal and ethical exposure that comes with supervising others.

BUSINESS READINESS

- ☐ I've thought about how supervision fits into my income — side income vs. main practice.
- ☐ I know whether I want to supervise independently, within an agency, or both.
- ☐ I'm ready to formalize contracts, documentation, and evaluation tools.
